


Interesting Bible Facts



CHRIST AS SEEN IN THE BOOK



OF JOSHUA

Jesus is portrayed in Joshua is a type of Christ, Captain of Salvation, Jesus is Commander of The Lord, The Man with Sword, and the Scarlet Cord of Rahab, typifies safety in the Blood of Christ, The Inheritance Giver.

● **BIBLICAL KNOWLEDGE- Did you know that Christians of The New Testament Covenant are not under Old Covenantal Laws?**

This includes the last day of the week as the Sabbath Rest. Christians worship on the **first day** of the week because Jesus was resurrected and appeared to some of his disciples on the **first day** of the week, His continued appearances were also on the **first day**, the descent of The Holy Spirit took place on the **first day**, the early church had a pattern of Sunday worship, the last vision given to the Apostle John by the risen Christ was on a Sunday (the Lord's Day), and scripture of Col 2:16,17 specifies that the Jewish last weekday Sabbath was not longer binding, and that all was fulfilled Christ.

A JANUARY EVENT -The Waldensians are among history's first evangelicals, pre-Protestants who sprang up in the 1200s in the Alps of Italy. The movement started when Peter Waldo of Lyons, a wealthy French merchant, became involved in translating the Bible into his own local language. His basic Christianity led to his removal from Lyons to the Italian Alps where his message of simple discipleship strengthened among Alpine Christians. They stressed love of Christ and His Word, and included a life of poverty. Their peculiarity invited the anger of the church, **making them targets for execution**. In 1251, the followers in Toulouse, France, **were massacred**, their town burned, and 20,000 farmers and shepherds, filled the French/Italian Alps. In 1655, **soldiers came against them, killing, torturing, raping, looting—hundreds were killed**. Survivors escaped into the French mountains and claimed protection plus freedom for French Protestants. The Waldensian communities increased with Protestant refugees. They found themselves caught between the Catholic forces of both France and Italy. On **January 31, 1686**, Louis XIV issued an edict to burn Waldensian churches to the ground. **Protestant assemblies were forbidden**, children were ordered baptized in the Catholic faith, and pastors deposed. The Waldensians were **trapped and massacred—2,000 killed**, 2,000 more “transformed” to Catholicism, **8,000 imprisoned**, half of whom soon died of starvation and sickness. Some returned to made their way from the Piedmont mountains of Europe to the Piedmont mountains of North Carolina. They established the town of Valdese where they live to this day, every summer presenting their story in the open-air drama *From This Day Forward*.
