"THE LORD IS FAITHFUL TO HIS PROMISES"





Lot was a member of the City of Sodom's ruling council, as a judge and was warned about the coming harm and given a chance to escape with the help of God's messengers. Lot's wife herself, was very hesitant about leaving her home and material possessions. Her heart had become attached to the lifestyle the city had provided.

A MARCH EVENT-George Wishart of Pitarrow, Scotland. was eager to both learn and teach. He believed that God's way of salvation was through the finished work of Christ alone. Those Reformation beliefs put him at risk. In 1544 he began preaching in Dundee from the book of Romans. Archbishop Beaton harshly sought to repress Protestants, and Wishart's arrest grew more certain and on the morning of March 1, 1546, Wishart was led to the stake. He was then strangled and his body burned to ashes. His death enraged all of Scotland, and within two months Archbishop Beaton was assassinated.. Many vowed not to rest till Scotland was Protestant. It proved a costly vow, for they were soon imprisoned on galley ships, chained to the oars with a whip to their backs, labouring to exhaustion with no hope of release. Some were eventually freed, and in years to come Protestantism took Scotland by storm, provoking rulers, inciting riots, demanding change. The Scots kept inspired for years to come, and the Reformation at last succeeded in their land.
