This month's coloured attachment scripture is 1 Corinthians

## Jesus is The Wisdom of God.

CORINTHIANS

\* BIBLICAL KNOWLEDGE- Did you know that God in His Sovereignty and Grace had chosen to use the Church's chief opponent as his instrument and transform him as one of the greatest leaders and missionary for Christ and the Body of Christ to both Jews and Gentiles alike in the history of The Church? Living in Damascus at this time, 34 A.D. was a devout observer of God's Word and a disciple of Christ, Ananias, a well respected Jewish man by the Jewish community dwelling there. Jesus appeared to Ananias in a vision and told him to go to a certain street and house where Paul was staying and that he was praying and expecting a man called Ananias to visit him and restore his sight in the Name of Jesus.

A JULY EVENT-Thomas Guthrie was born on July 12, 1803 to a prosperous merchant and his spiritual wife. He entered the University of Edinburgh at age 12, studied physical sciences, and graduated at 16. His inclinations were toward theological studies, and in 1830 assumed the pastorate of a small congregation in Arbirlot, Scotland. He started with forming cottage prayer meetings, Sunday schools, and a parish library. His preaching was uncompromising, friendly, and well received. Guthrie was soon made minister of Old Gray Friars Church in Edinburgh, then of St. John's Church in Edinburgh's slums. He established ministries to the poor, whom he frequently visited. His best-known program was the Ragged Schools for juvenile delinguents. He fiercely promoted total abstinence, seeing daily the effects of alcohol on the unfortunate. The poor loved him, yet his outgoing personality, deep enthusiasm, and fertile sermons appealed to the higher classes of society, and Guthrie soon became the most popular minister in Scotland. He turned from pastoring to spend his remaining years editing a Christian magazine. In 1873, his funeral procession tracked through a crowd of 30,000 spectators which included 230 children from the original Ragged School.
