The Lord Himself takes charge of His people. It is the responsibility of the shepherd to tend and care for, to provide and to protect all the flock of sheep, most of all, for guidance and leadership. The Image of God as a Shepherd alludes to His continual direction and care for His people.


Shepherd is a title used of God and His people are His flock. **The Shepherd saves those** who are lost or scattered, the Shepherd also judges and appoints other faithful leaders to lead and guide His people; He will judge any corrupt leaders who have exploited His people. His people are known as sheep.

God promised to raise up a future shepherd from the Royal Line of David. **God promises restoration**, His Sovereignty affirms He is in control all the time, even a tragic situation He can turn to be good.

This verse leads to a fulfilment in Christ, **The Good Excellent Shepherd**, for each individual to follow as their Saviour. **The Lord promised to rescue the scattered flock and care for them as a loving Shepherd.** Corrupt, thoughtless, greedy leaders do not give people peace.




Jesus is portrayed as A Tender Twig that Becomes a Stately Cedar, The Rightful King, The True Shepherd.

BIBLICAL KNOWLEDGE- Did you know that when Jewish tax collectors who were employed by the Roman Empire, as well as many sinners gathered to hear Jesus, the Pharisees and Teachers of The Law muttered how He welcomed sinners and disapproved that He ate with them? They were ashamed to be associated with sinners, but Christ was not. Jesus associated with sinners because His purpose was and is to save the lost. constables arrested him, and on **October 9, 1664** he stood a prisoner in the court of Aylesbury before the Chief Justice. **His book was publically burnt**. Keach actually spent two months in prison and paid one hundred pounds, but he got into trouble again, this time for **publishing a hymnal**. English-speaking churches had previously sung only the psalms of David, usually to ponderous tunes. In 1691 Keach **published a book of 300 lively hymns**. Such a radical innovation upset his congregation, and he watched with alarm as many members left. Keach spent the rest of his life in the 'disgraceful pursuits' of teaching children and singing hymns.
