
God is pleased with His people who follow after what is good and godly.

A SETEMBER EVENT-During the mid-1850s. America was wavering on the brink of civil war impassioned opinions. A depression had halted construction and factory output. Banks were failing; unemployment soared. Spiritual weariness permeated the land. In New York City, Jeremiah C. Lanphier, accepted the call of the North Reformed Dutch Church to a full-time program of evangelism. He visited homes, placed posters, and prayed but grew discouraged. He decided to try prayer meetings, thinking that businessmen might attend during their lunch hours. He announced the first one for September 23, 1857, at the Old Dutch Church Finally, one man showed up, then a few others, the next week, 20 came, the third week, 40, and within months the building was overflowing. This revitalization spread to other cities. Offices and stores closed for prayer at noon. Newspapers spread the story, even telegraph companies set aside certain hours. In these cities, prayer services began at noon people could come and go as they pleased. The service opened with a hymn, followed

by the sharing of testimonies and prayer requests. Virtually no great preachers or famous Christians were used. It was primarily a lay movement, led by the gentle moving of God's Spirit. The revival—sometimes called "The Third Great Awakening"—lasted nearly two years, and approximately 1,000,000 people were said to have been converted to Christ. Out of it came the largest outlay of money for humanitarian and Christian causes America had yet experienced.
