

## "MAN SHALL NOT LIVE BY BREAD ALONE BUT BY EVERY WORD OF GOD"


The basic truth is encompassed in this statement. **People are not to act apart from faithful dependence upon God.** God wants His people to subsist on every word that proceeds from God, to trust Him for their needs and to meet their provisions as He promises.

God made provision for food in His physical creation and His spiritual creation. Bread is the basic component of humankind's physical diet and God's Word is the food for spiritual life. **Bread sustains physical life, but it is no endorsement for spiritual life, which is God's gift.** 

Eternal Life is given to those who trust in and live by His Word, His Statutes and His Pledges, being in complete dependence upon Him. Reliance upon God arises out of an awareness of human helplessness, especially spiritual hunger. Mankind's condition is structured to rely upon God The Creator for true spiritual food.

There is the emptiness of misplaced dependence in the misquoted Word of God. Faithfulness to God's Word takes precedence over self-need. What does not agree with Scripture does not come from God. People are not animals just living for physical needs. Childlike dependence and reliability in God's Word is necessary for spiritual strength. God's Word is living, is active and it endures forever.

A SEPTEMBER EVENT-One day in 1769, Mary Redfern, who lived in Derbyshire, England, heard a commotion in the street. John Wesley was preaching before a crowd in the open. Wesley's evangelists, also came preaching. One spoke from 1 Chronicles 4:9 about Jabez, "the most respected son in his family." Mary never forgot the story of Jabez. She married and named her firstborn Jabez. Wesley preached in Manchester and Mary took little Jabez. The great evangelist touched the child and blessed him. Little did he know he was blessing his upcoming successor. Young Jabez often heard Wesley preach, and developed a great love for the gospel.

At 19 he preached his first official sermon and was ordained to the ministry. Jabez Bunting rose to the Methodism leadership following Wesley's death. One of several controversies occurred on **September 9**, **1825**, when the Brunswick Chapel opened in Leeds. A dispute began amongst parishioners over **whether an organ should be installed in the sacred building.** Many members opposed it, but Jabez and the leaders installed it anyway. The organ, it was later said, cost 1,000 pounds plus 1,000 Methodists.
